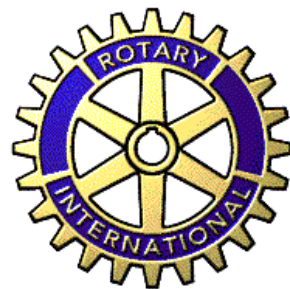

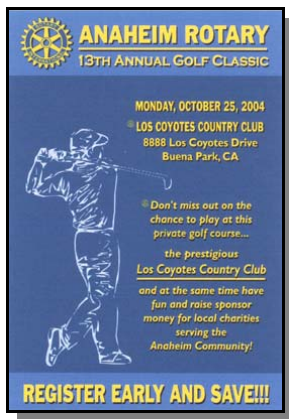

## Program Highlights

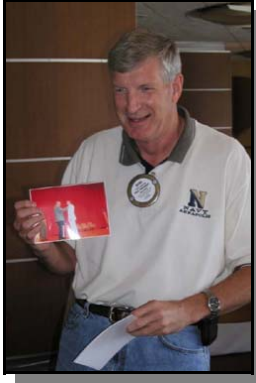

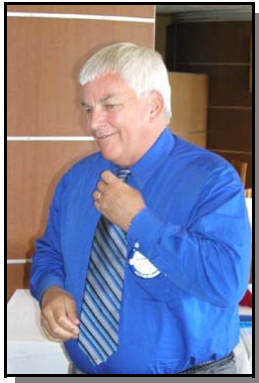
