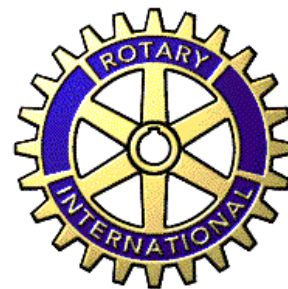

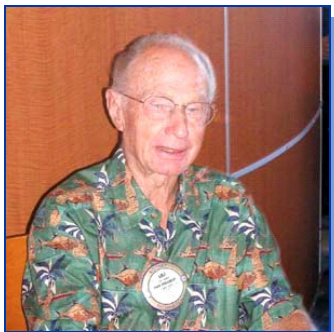

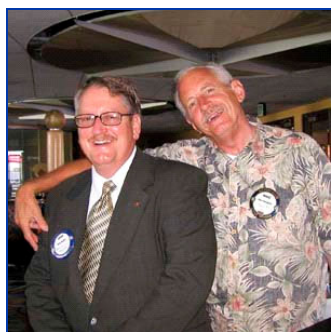
Dear President Vic --- what about craft talks???
