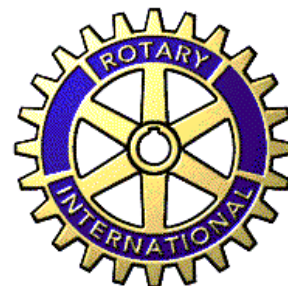

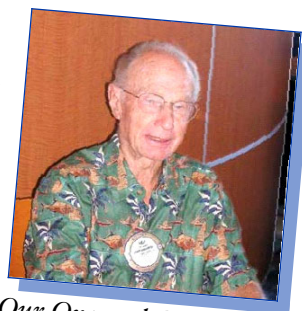
Program Highlights

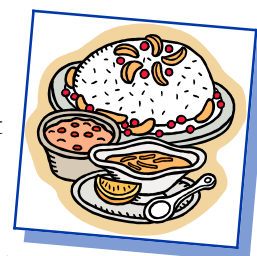

Old PP Greg Lewis on Vacation

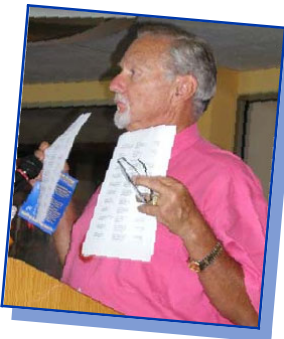
I don't know where Greg may be, but he sent **Jill Conn** from his office to represent him... way to go Greg!
