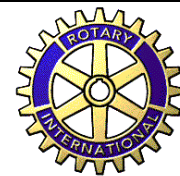

Mike “Way-Out Liberal Democrat” Baker

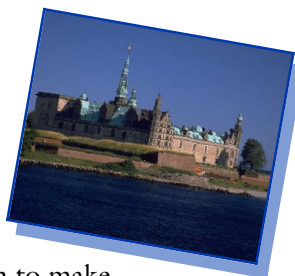
