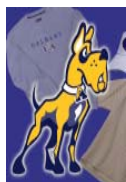




The Weekly Squeak

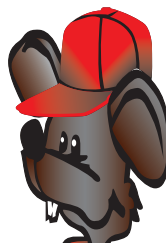
