Some of the requested funds were put off until next term since their monies would not be needed or used until 2006. Recipients were: Anaheim Interfaith Shelter \$2,500; Anaheim Police Activities League \$2,500; Earth Connections \$1,000; Haskett Library \$1,000; Leadership Anaheim \$500; Trails 4 All \$1,000; Anaheim Family YMCA \$6,000; and Acaciawood School \$500. But that's not all . . . for the fiscal year 2004/05, our Anaheim Rotary has given \$57,323 to charitable causes!! Now THAT'S community service at its finest!

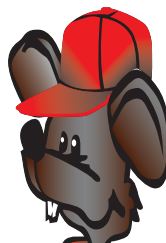
