Hey, it doesn't matter if it's only 10 bucks . . . I'm on vacation! Next week it's back to suits and ties.

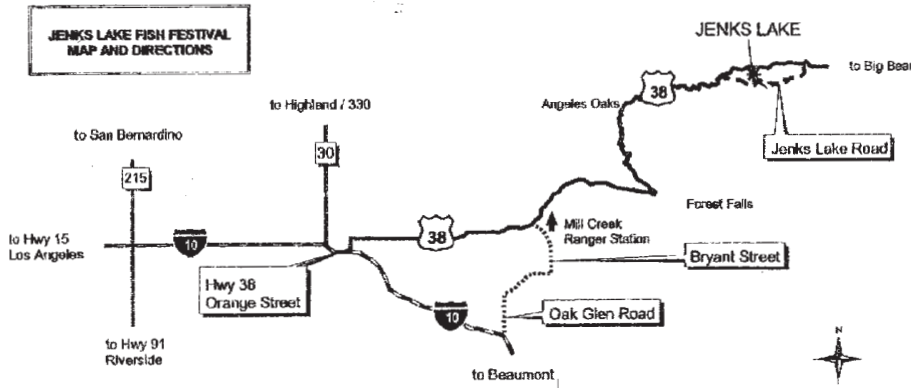

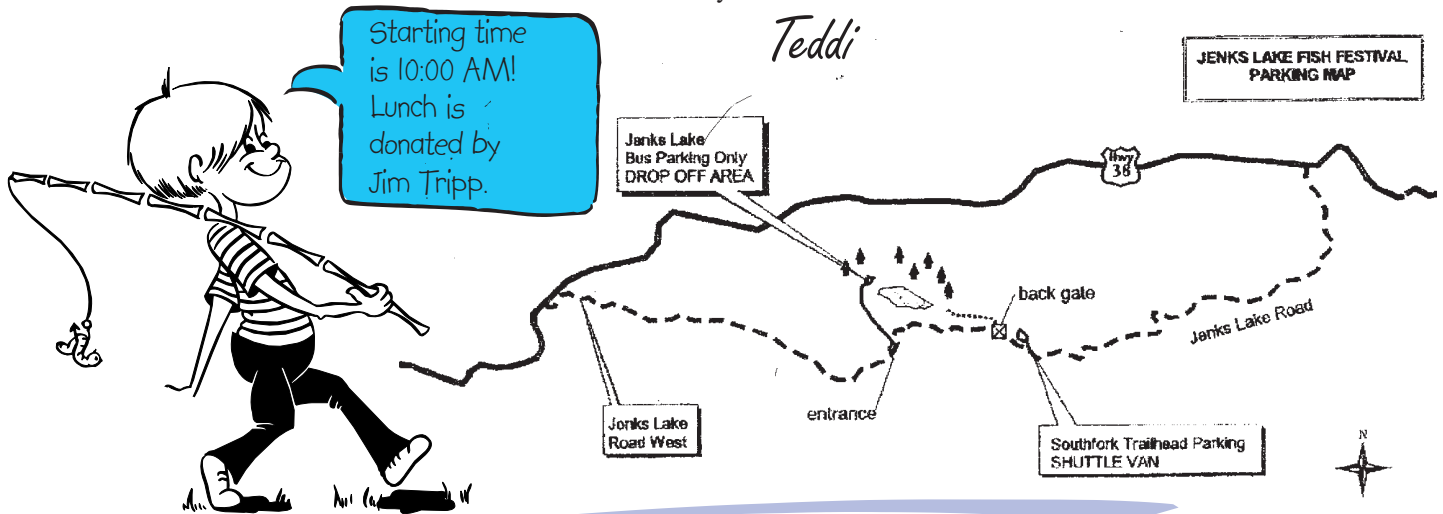
