Meeting Highlights



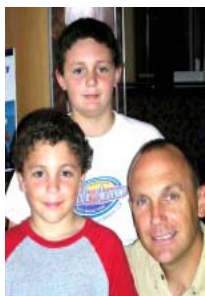

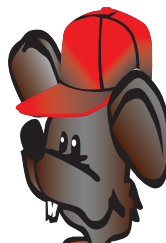
