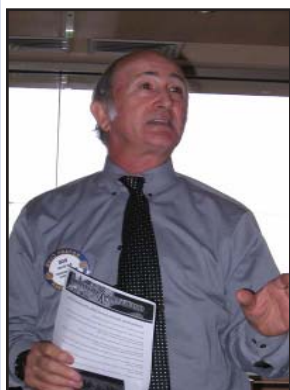
Meeting Highlights

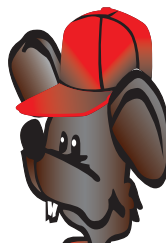

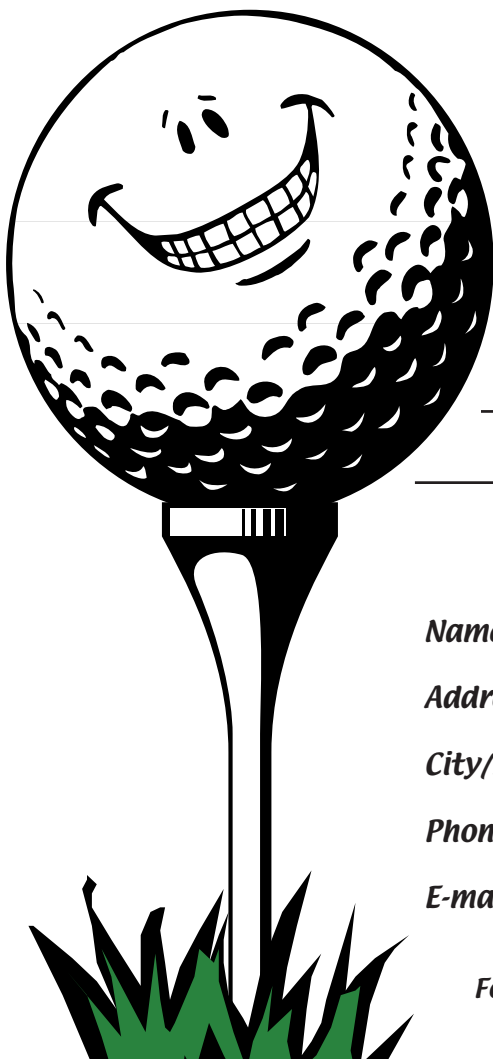
