Mr. Berger has also said he will address all the questions on our "Berger Q&A" webpage by this Friday, March 28th. I will update the page when I get the input from his office.

For those of you who have retained The Law Firm of Michael Jay Berger, he has acknowledged all 546 clients (either individual or with co-signers) by way of an email receipt. In my last E-Blast, I wrote of the news that Attorney Lown's Law Firm has graciously backed out of the battle and endorsed the Berger Law Firm. The following is Michael Berger's response and an update on our case:

"I thank Mr. Lown for his endorsement, and I welcome his former clients to our group.

"In the same spirit, I have reached out to Charles Mitchell, the father of 2 SSH pilots and co-signer for one, and a partner at the Texas law firm of Brown & Dean. Like me, Mr. Mitchell is an "AV" rated attorney and a member of the legal fraternity Phi Alpha Delta. Mr. Mitchell is recovering from a heart attack and quadruple bypass surgery, but he is still deeply concerned about what is best for the SSH students. Mr. Mitchell told me that he has signed up 35 SSH students. Like Mr. Lown, he is considering whether or not he should continue to represent these students or refer them to another law firm. I hope to have an announcement to make in this regard later this week.

"We have begun preparation of the proofs of claim for all of our SSH clients. We are continuing our legal and factual research regarding (1) The Adversary Proceeding that we will be filing against SSH, EOS, AES, Student Loan Xpress, KeyBank, Liberty Bank, Citibank and others; (2) The Fraudulent and Preferential Transfers by SSH; and (3) All state programs that may be of help to our clients. We are reviewing documents, interviewing witnesses, talking to counsel for other creditors, and strategizing with the United States Trustee, The United States Attorney, attorneys from the offices of different State Attorney Generals, Bankruptcy Judges, Trustees, and other Certified Specialist in Bankruptcy Law. Georgeann, Gail and I are deeply committed to helping each and every one of our SSH clients.
