We have completed our filing of Proofs of Claim for each and every one of the 1,367 former SSH Students that we represent. We have sent individual confirmations to many of these clients at their request. . . . If you are our client in the SSH case, the preparation and filing of your Proof of Claim is just one of the services that we provide for you. If you are a former SSH student and you are not our client, we urge you to file your Proof of Claim before the July 21 Bar Date."

That is next Monday. Get it done.

And on June 19th:

"AES/Student Loan Xpress Suspends Interest Accrual and Payments on SSH Student Loans"

If you read the letter from Senator Nelson to Donna, he gives some information regarding the FBI. In a nutshell: "To file a complaint with the FBI, you may contact: Ms. Maureen Seitz, Victim Specialist, FBI Las Vegas, ... (702) 584-5523 ... Case number 318E LV 40690"

From what I understand, to get access to the FBI Victim interview form, you must get some documentation by mail from Ms. Seitz. Letters to Senators

Now, I haven't done this yet. But I am a busy procrastinator. I was scheduled to join Procrastinators Anonymous, but have gotten around to going to a meeting

You should all write a letter (handwritten is best, but computer typed is okay – just not an email – use the post office) to your US Senators. In California, that would be The Honorable Senators Boxer and Feinstein. The website for addresses is:

The letter should include: who you are; how you found out about SSH; how you got funding for the school (you are rich, you took out a home equity loan, the school pointed you toward one of the lenders in question); if you were hooked up with one of the lenders, how soon were your funds disbursed (mine were issued all within four days by the third week of ground school); what you were promised; how your school didn't fulfill that promise; how you are now in trouble (financially, stress; your credentials being tainted by the SS reputation); etc.

Attorney Andrew August of the Pinnacle Law Group related to me today that the California class action is proceeding and a similar class action has been file in Nevada State Court around two weeks ago.

According to Ask.com, class action n. A lawsuit brought by one or more plaintiffs on behalf of a large group of others who have a common interest.

One of many items sent to me by Jiri Myslin:
